Instruction: Answer any three (3) questions in the answer booklet provided.

1. a) As an early grade student teacher, you have identified that your learners are fond of eating with unclean hands. In five (5) simple steps, demonstrate how you would assist them to wash their hands properly to improve their personal hygiene. (5 Marks)
- b) You have been called upon during a PA meeting to discuss child obesity among your early grade learners. Discuss (with practical examples) five (5) reasons you will highlight for healthy eating among the learners. (10 Marks)
- c) Child abuse has become rampant these days in schools. As an Early Grade student teacher, identify five (5) Child Rights Policies in Ghana that can address this menace. (5 Marks)

2. a) The current technological advancement has led to child obesity resulting from technological games such as watching of cartoons on the television, smart phone games, etc. At a parent forum in your school, educate parents on five (5) reasons, with practical examples, why there is the need for their Early Grade wards to be allowed to engage more in Traditional Games and Dances instead of the cartoons and smart phones. (15 Marks)
- b) Creating a serene and conducive environment for learners is one of the major tasks of you as an Early Grade student teacher. In what five (5) ways will you ensure safe and a healthy learning environment for your learners? (5 Marks)
3. a) Child play is a major part of **Early Grade** Curriculum. With practical examples, discuss five (5) measures you will take into consideration as an Early Grade teacher when you are on the field with your learners to minimize injuries and promote safety of the learners. (15 Marks)
- 3) You have been given the opportunity at a staff meeting to brief your colleagues on their responsibilities with respect to Child Right and Protection issues. As an Early Grade student teacher, outline five (5) responsibilities of early grade teachers. (5 Marks)
4. a) One of the Early Grade Schools in Ghana normally finds human faeces in the classroom. The community also has its refuse dump site just by the school. As the SHEP Coordinator, discuss five (5) ways of ensuring a safe and a healthy school environment for the community. (15 Marks)
- b) There have been rampant motor accidents involving school buses in Ghana in recent times. As an Early Grade teacher, suggest ten (10) items that must be in the First Aid Kit on the School Bus. (5 Marks)
5. Your attention was drawn to a fight between two of your Early Grade learners during break time. On your arrival, you found out that one of them had sustained **cardiac arrest** and was **unconscious**. Discuss, in detail, how you would perform BASIC CPR on the child until a medical team arrives. (Take into consideration activities to be done before and during the CPR). (20 Marks)

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
